The journey includes sightseeing of the Berlin Cathedral, Museum Island, Victory Column, the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church, the famous Unter den Linden street. One of the most important places on tour are the Third Reich and the Cold War landmarks - Hermann Goring's Aviation Ministry, Hitler's Bunker, Berlin Wall, and Checkpoint Charlie.
