Typical Merchant's Houses

15 min

Traditional red brick houses are the special feature of all Hansaetic towns. Lübeck has a great number of those carefully preserved.



St. Mary's Church

20 min

St. Mary's Church in Lübeck was built between 1250 and 1350. It has always been a symbol of the power and prosperity of the old Hanseatic city and is situated at the highest point of the island that forms the old town of Lübeck.



Wismar Market Square

20 min

As Wismar was the second founding town of the Hanseatic Trade league, the center of the old town is the huge Market Place, one of the largest in northern Germany, surrounded by elegant buildings with styles ranging from 14th-century North German Gothic to 19th-century Romanesque Revival to Art Nouveau.

Start with the exciting drive from the Travemünde port to the town of Lübeck.

08:45 - 12:00

Panoramic walk through the Queen of the Hanseatic League as Lübeck is often called. Make numerous photo stops, including the stop at St. Marien church, the town hall and market, the landmark Holsten Gate and many other.

12:00 - 12:30

Free time for lunch.
