Molli Steam Train

20 min

Molli Steam Train is a small steam-powered train that runs down the 15-kilometer long track between the Baltic sea coast and Rostok. It's a great experience to take the slow ride along the spectacular sea beaches or gorgeous countryside. When the wintertime comes, the trains are replaced with "Mollibuses" that run along the same route.



Warnemünde Lighthouse

10 min

Warnemünde is a Baltic seaside resort and a district of the city of Rostock. Founded in about 1200, Warnemünde was for centuries a small fishing village. Warnemünde has numerous navigational aids, the oldest being the lighthouse, built-in 1897, and still currently in use.



"Old Stream" canal

10 min

Warnemünde Old Stream canal or Alte Strom is a beautiful bay with the draw bridge, full with the fishermen's boats, restaurants and pubs. The surrounding streets are full of small colorful houses. The main attraction of the area is the fish market with the fresh Baltic sea catch.

Meet your guide outside the main port gate.

09:00 - 10:00

We'll start with a walking tour of Warnemuende with the photo stops at the Lighthouse and the Old Steam canal.

10:00 - 10:30

Depart to Rostock by the public train and tram.

10:30 - 12:30

Walking tour of Rostock old town including town hall, boulevard, university, town wall & gates, monastery, merchant's homes and many more. Inside visit to St. Marien Church with astronomical clock.

12:30 - 13:45

Free time to have a lunch at a local cafe on your own or to stroll along the promenade



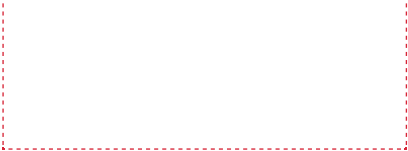
DAY PLAN
