Rock Church 30 min

Temppeliaukion Church is often called the church in the rock. Finland blends the natural landscape of the region to create the beautiful urban environment and this is the best example of it. The church is built into the huge granite rock. It's simple but very elegant with granite walls and glass ceiling. Services daily.



Helsinki Cathedral 30 min

Helsinki Cathedral is a gorgeous white Lutheran church also called the Cathedral of St. Nicholas. It's the main church of the town. The church was opened in 1852 and dedicated to the name saint of Russian emperor Nicholas 1st, as Finland was the province of Russia at that time



Uspenski Cathedral

Located on a hill above the Helsinki harbor, red brick Uspensky cathedral can be seen from far away. It's the largest Orthodox Church of Northern Europe. The style of the cathedral is a tribute to the Russian Revival period when the best of the old times architectural ideas were used to create the magnificent constructions. The church is worth going inside to see the impressive iconostases.



Central Train Station

20 min

The Central Train Station of Helsinki is a large impressive building, decorated with the massive statues on the both sides of the doors. Mannerheimintie

15 min

Mannerheimintie is the main street of Helsinki, as well as the longest street of the city. It follows the path of the old road to Tampere>, Finland's old capital. Mannerheimintie begins at the Esplanada street and goes all the way north to the city limits.



Market Square 45 min

Market square in the center of Helsinki is the most exciting place of the city. It's located on the seashore next to the ferry. You can find everything there. All sorts of season fruit and berries, mushrooms, smoked fish, flowers, souvenirs, traditional clothing, furs, leather, name it. One can spend hours digging through the carved bone statuettes or enjoying the beer with fresh grilled salmon.

Detailed Program Best of Helsinki Join-in Shore Excursion

08:45 - 09:00

Meet your guide and driver outside the main port gate.

09:00 - 11:20

Depart for a scenic drive through the downtown of Helsinki. The first stop after being picked up from the ship is Market Square. The tour continues along beautiful Esplanadi and Mannerheim streets up to Central Train Station. Our driver will also take you along such sights as Uspensky cathedral, Presidential Palace, National Museum and Finlandia Hall, Opera House, Finlandia Concert Hall and Parlament Building.

11:20 - 11:50

The next t remarkable place of Helsinki you are goin to see is the Olympic Stadium. Back in 1952, the Olympic Games were held in Finland. Quite close to the Stadium is the Sibelius Park with a monument to Ian Sibelius - a great Finnish composer. You will also have

a possibility to take photos here.

-0-11:50 - 12:20 DAY PLAN

Our guide then will take you to see the Rock Church. This is a unique highlight in Helsinki and is considered to be one of the Europe's most interesting churches. Being carved out of solid rock, it has a copper dome installed. The church's interior is bathed in natural light which enters here through the dome. The church is used frequently as a concert venue due to its excellent acoustic, which is ensured by the rocky surfaces.

12:20 - 12:50

Our panoramic tour concludes by relaxing walk in the city center of Finnish capital. Being a step closer to the beauties you've seen from the window - what could be better? After the walk you can either have your lunch in a local restaurant in the center and have some free time for shopping, or you can return back to the ship together with your

group.
