The Viking Ship Museum houses archaeological finds from different areas of Scandinavia. The main attractions are the Oseberg ship, Gokstad ship and Tune ship. Additionally, the Viking Age display includes sledges, beds, a horse cart, wood carving, tent components, buckets and other grave goods.

		along the waterfront till you get to Bygdøynes. Once there, you will visit the Kon- Tiki museum - a place that houses original vessels and artifacts from the world- renowned expeditions of Thor Heyerdahl, one of the most famous schentists, adventurers and environmental campaigners of all time.	
	12:30 - 13:00	At the end of the tour, you will catch the ferry back to the city center.	
	13:00 - 15:00	Walk through the Oslo center.	
	15:00 - 15:05	Flnish the tour in the city center. Free time to explore Oslo on your own.
