On this Walking tour, you will stroll along beautiful Esplanadi and Mannerheim streets up to Central Train Station and the monument to the prominent ruler of Finland - marshal Gustav Mannerheim. | book. | DAY PLAN | | Church (upon availability, might be closed due to religious and private events). This is a unique highlight in Helsinki and is considered to be one of Europe's most interesting churches. Being carved out of solid rock, it has a copper dome installed. The church's interior is bathed in natural light which enters here through the dome. The church is used frequently as a concert venue due to its excellent acoustics, which is ensured by the rocky surfaces. | |
| | 12:45 - 13:00 | The tour concludes in the city center. After the end of the guided walking tour, you will have free time to continue exploring Helsinki on your own, to have lunch or do some shopping. Please note that the passengers are responsible for their transfer back to the cruise ship. The Port is 15-minutes walking distance away. You may also use the same tram as at the beginning of the tour. | |
