Highlights Aarhus Private Walking Tour



ARoS Art Museum 20 min

The name ARoS refers to the Old Danish name of the city Aarhus, Áros, while the capitalized letters of the name hint at the Latin word for art, namely ars. It is the oldest public art museum in Denmark outside of Copenhagen. ARoS has a large art collection with works from the Golden Age until today.



Aarhus Cathedral

20 min

Aarhus Cathedral is dedicated to the patron saint of sailors, St. Clemens. The cathedral is located on the port side of the central square in the inner city. The church can seat around 1200 people. Aarhus Cathedral has many fresco paintings dating from 1470 to 1520.



Viking Museum

20 min

It is a small underground museum, located at the square of Skt. Clemens Market. It is located beneath the Nordea bank building and on the site of an archaeological excavation of the 1960s, 3 m (9.8 ft) below street level. The excavations revealed various Viking Age structures, items, and parts of a human skeleton. The museum provides information regarding the history of Viking Age Aarhus.

Enjoy a delightful walk through Aarhus old town with great photo opportunities at the Cathedral of Aarhus, the longest and tallest church in Denmark that dates back to the 12th century; the Viking Museum, that will tell you the history of Viking way of life with its amazing traditions and rituals; and the ARoS Art Museum, which is one of the largest art museums in Northern Europe.

The walking tour will end at The Old City where you will be able to explore Den Gamle By on your own. Den Gamle By is an open-air
